

Afro-Hispanic Review

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The editor of the *Afro-Hispanic Review* invites submissions of unpublished studies pertaining to the literature, history, and culture of the African presence and influence in the Hispanic world. The editor also welcomes interdisciplinary work, book reviews, translations, creative writings, and relevant developments, of the highest quality, as they relate to Afro-Hispanic experience in Spanish, English, and Portuguese.

Articles should be prepared in compliance with the requirements established by the *MLA Style Manual* and the *MLA Handbook for Writers of Research Papers*, 6th edition (2003). Manuscripts should consist of approximately 6,000 words. The original and a copy must be submitted, along with a digital copy and a self-addressed envelope and return postage. All manuscripts are anonymously refereed. Therefore, the manuscripts should contain no obvious reference to the author, though the author's name, address, telephone number, and email address should be included on a separate title page. A current subscription to the journal is strongly recommended before the manuscript undergoes the review process.

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
