All manuscripts are anonymously refereed. Therefore, the manuscripts should contain no obvious reference to the author, though the author's name, address, telephone number, and email address should be included on a separate title page. A current subscription to the journal is strongly recommended before the manuscript undergoes a review process.

The *Afro-Hispanic Review* will be published twice annually by the Department of Spanish and Portuguese at Vanderbilt University. Annual subscription rates for two issues are: Individuals: \$30.00.
